Our devoted and enthusiastic staff has consistently met and often surpassed the goals of development set by itself and hence maintained a benchmark in performance in notable spheres of activities

Brief History of the College

Located in the idyllic and enticing Pabbar valley, in the vicinity of Mata Hateshwari temple, LBS GDC Saraswati Nagar has served as an institution that shapes the future and directs aspirations of pupils toward successful careers and higher goals of life. LBS Govt. College Saraswati Nagar an institution of eminence in Himachal Pradesh came into being in 1986. The opening of the college in such a hard area marked the beginning of a new intellectual climate in the entire region. Since then this college has been providing various opportunities for the youth of this area and has been enabling them to acquire skills and confidence to face the challenges of the world. The college has come a long way with its motto "To provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values & social commitment". During the session 2019-20, PG courses in the subjects of Political Science and History were introduced in the college. In 2023-24 PG Courses in English, Hindi and Commerce too were introduced in the college along with Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) in two sectors of Retail Management and Hospitality & Tourism Management.

BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE COLLEGE

A) EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND COURSES OFFERED

(1) UNDER-GRADUATE LEVEL

The college offers and has 5 UG pass courses: B.A., B.Sc., B.Com BCA and B.Voc in Retail Management and Hospitality & Tourism Management. However, both the courses follow the semester system.

(2) POST-GRADUATE LEVEL

The College provides Post-graduate courses in Political Science, History, English, Hindi and Commerce. The strength in these courses has not only increased but also has given good results. Besides this, self-financing course in PGDCA is also operational in the College.

B) INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

We have upgraded our infrastructure and are constantly in process of doing the same, so that our students find themselves second to none as far as exposure and modern facilities that supplement education are concerned. Our achievements include:

(1) Highest Accolade

The college has received highest accolade in the form of special grants in Cores of rupees for the construction of Multipurpose Hall, New Academic block, Indoor stadium and leveling of playground for the smooth functioning of sports activities.

(2) Library

The college has a voluminous and spacious library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about 13452 books on different subjects including a book bank. It has subscribed 7 newspapers, 10 magazines and 7 Journals to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is also a member of Inlibnet Ahmedabad and NDLI Kharagpur. It is also automated with SOUL3.0 Software.

(3) Laboratories

The college has four spacious Science laboratories including Geography lab(one) and English Language lab(one).

(4) Hostel (Girls)

There is a girls' hostel in the college that provides boarding facilities to the meritorious and deserving students. The hostel is equipped with Water Purifiers, Solar-heating Systems, Sick Room, Guest Room and Reading Room.

(4) Computer Lab

Keeping in pace with the hi-tech and competitive world, the college is equipped with 65 computers which are installed in English language lab and 3 IT labs. These labs are also provided with over-head projectors and broad-band connections. Besides IT department, students from various faculties are being benefitted by the Computer Labs.

(5) Seminar Hall/Conference Hall

To hold meetings, to organize Conferences and Seminars, the college has a well-furnished seminar hall.

(6) Canteen

The college canteen is a place of refreshment for the college staff as well as students. It offers a great variety of food items and snacks at nominal prices.

(7) Playground and Synthetic Track

The playground of the college provides for organizing various outdoor games like volleyball, kabaddi, boxing, etc. Besides, there is a synthetic athletic track awaiting completion.

(8) Gymnasium

Keeping in mind the fitness in this hectic and stressful era, the college provides free of cost gymnasium facility to the students and the college staff.

(9) Pavilion

The college can boast of a magnificent pavilion building built adjacent to the ground to witness plethora of sports events.
