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



Outcome Report 2021-22Dated 17th August 2022




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
Five Year Perspective Plan for Future Development4th Oct. 2022

IQAC Annual Review Meeting

On 30th May, 2023, the IQAC of LBS GDC Saraswati Nagar convened its annual review meeting to evaluate the measures implemented in response to the IQAC recommendations for the session 2022-23. These recommendations were made on the basis of inputs gathered from various stakeholders, including the Principal, teachers, students, and alumni, as well as discussions with the insightful Advisory Council of the college. The key points of the meeting are as follows :

- 1. Vocational Courses:** The institution obtained government approval to initiate B.Voc. courses in Retail Management and Tourism & Hospitality Management, aligning with professional education and alumni vision.
- 2. PG Courses:** Approval was secured to start M.A. courses in Hindi and English, as well as M.Com., to provide local avenues for postgraduate education.
- 3. Infrastructure Development:** Construction of a college parking facility commenced to accommodate the increasing number of staff and student vehicles.
- 4. Academic Support:** Remedial English language classes were conducted to enhance writing and communication skills for weaker students, based on feedback from parents and students.
- 5. Career Counseling:** Special classes for competitive exams and higher studies were organized, following suggestions from alumni. Interactive sessions with experts from Chitkara University and Nimbus Academy were held.
- 6. Departmental Initiatives:** Departments of Philosophy, Chemistry, Hindi, Commerce, and Geography conducted **experiential learning** sessions and **educational trips**, fostering practical learning.
- 7. Campus Beautification:** Responding to student and alumni suggestions, flower beds were laid, ornamental plants cultivated, and cleanliness drives organized to beautify the campus. Awareness drives for a plastic-free campus were conducted regularly.
- 8. PGDCA Course:** PGDCA course commenced from the session 2022-23, expanding the institution's course offerings.
- 9. Professional Development:** Teachers completed an FDP in National Education Policy 2020 from Teaching Learning Centre, Ramanujan College, Delhi, or IGNOU. Additionally, participation in various FDPs and refresher courses related to higher education and advanced learning was emphasized.

Action Taken Report 2022-23

On the basis of the feedback obtained from the various stakeholders of the institution (Principal, teachers, students and alumni) and discussions with the sagacious Advisory Council of the college, appropriate actions have been taken keeping in view the requirements of the institution.

- Taking into consideration the scenario of professional education and vision of our alumni, the college sought permission from the government to start B.Voc. courses in Retail Management and Tourism & Hospitality management from the session 2023-24.
- To provide avenues for Post Graduate courses locally, the college got approval from the government to start M.A. course in Hindi and English, and M.Com. from the session 2023-24.
- Keeping in view the increase in number of staff and student vehicles, the process of construction of the college parking has started.
- Remedial classes in English language were taken for the weaker students in order to develop writing and communication skills, as per suggestions from parents and students.
- As per suggestions from the college alumni, Career Counseling and Guidance Cell has given special classes to students of outgoing classes for competitive exams and higher studies. The cell also organized an interactive session with experts from Chitkara University and another with Nimbus Academy, Shimla. The Department of Hindi provided coaching classes to students of B.A. III for M.A. Hindi entrance exam.
- As suggested by our students to focus on practical learning, the teachers were directed to the needful wherever possible. Dr. Poonam Mehta (Philosophy), Dr. Shallu (Chemistry), Asst. Prof. Ravi Prakash Sharma (Hindi), Asst. Prof. Sandeep Kumar (Commerce) and Asst. Prof. Kailash Chauhan (Geography) conducted experiential learning sessions for students in their respective subjects. The Department of Geography conducted an educational field trip to Dhar village in Jubbal to study topographic and agricultural patterns. Also, the Department of Commerce organized an educational trip to Kullu-Manali region for its students.
- It has been suggested by students and alumni of the institution to further beautify the college campus. Flower beds have been laid in front of the campus. Ornamental plants have been cultivated. Extension activities students conduct timely cleanliness drives on campus. Besides this, to enable a plastic free campus, awareness drives were periodically conducted for students.
- PGDCA course has started from the session 2022-23.
- In order to be in tandem with the changing scenario in education, the teachers completed an FDP in National Education Policy 2020 from Teaching Learning Centre, Ramanujan College, Delhi or IGNOU.
