World Environment Day (05.06.2022)

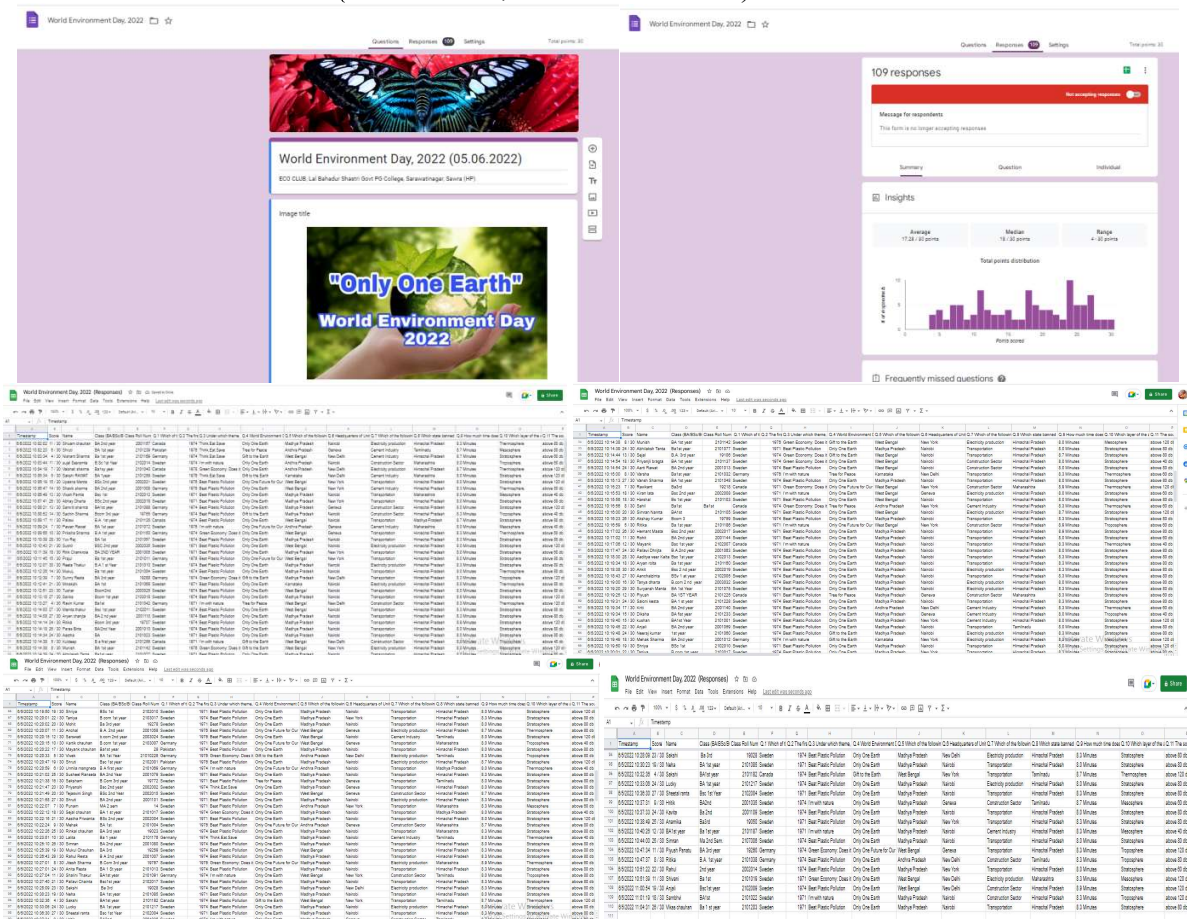

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National Science Day (28.02.2023)

India celebrates National Science Day on 28th February every year to commemorate the discovery of the 'Raman Effect'. Sir CV Raman discovered the effect in 1928 and was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930. National Science Day is celebrated across schools and other educational institutes to spread the message of the importance of science in daily life. On this day, light is shed on efforts and achievements in the field of science and dialogue is held on implementing new technologies. In 1986, the National Council for Science & Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the government of India to mark February 28 as National Science Day. National Science Day was first celebrated on February 28, 1987. The NCSTC also founded the National Science Popularization awards to recognize the outstanding efforts in the area of science. For 2022, Science and Technology Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh released the theme '**Global Science for Global Wellbeing**'. The theme has been chosen for the purpose of raising public appreciation of scientific issues in a global context which is having a bearing on global Well-being.

The event started with the welcome speech by the Ms Tejasvini of B.Sc. Final Year at 11:00 am. Chief guest Dr P.P. Chauhan, Principal, Govt. Degree College Saraswatinagar and other faculty members Dr Lalita Rawat, Vice Principa, Dr Poonam Mehta and Prof Chander Sen, senior faculty member were also present to encourage our students. The event continued with the rosette ceremony of the distinguished guests. All the science faculty members, lab assistants and students (39) were invited to witness the program. Judges for the competitions were Prof. Goverdhan, Asstt Prof. Maths, Dr Radha Raman Gautam, Asstt Prof. Physics and Dr Shallu Dogra, Asstt Prof Chemistry. Various competitions were conducted during this event like Quiz, Power Point Presentations, Debate, Model and Posters. The program proceeded with the Quiz conducted by Dr Punam Chauhan, Asstt Prof. Zoology and Dr Shallu Dogra, Asstt. Prof. Chemistry. There were four teams in quiz competition each with four participants. Quiz was based on science related topics. After the quiz, Power Point Presentaions were conducted by Ms Tejasvini and Mr Hemant. Ten students took part in it and they gave wonderful and brain storming presentations on various topics like 'Is Gravity an Illusion', 'Digestive System & Disease', 'Green Chemistry', 'Hot tea consumption & oesophageal cancer', 'Chloroplast', 'Scalar & Vector Products' 'Xenotransplantation', 'Chemical Bonding', 'Medicinal Plants' and 'Quantum Physics' covering all streams of sciences. After this, two groups of the students each with three participants presented their debate on a burning issue 'Should Human be Multiplanetarian'. Team A (Upasana, Muskan & Aastha) expressed their views for the statement and Team B (Sushil, Aaditya & Hemant) talked against it. Later the event continued with the Model Presentation, in which three teams participated. Team A (Aastha & Kiran) presented working model of 'Human Heart' and explained its working, Team B (Upasana, Mridul, Himanshu & Abhay) presented working model on 'Wireless Electricity' and explained its principle and mechanism and Team C (Tejasvini & Yogeshwari) presented their experiment based on Chemistry including 'Electrolysis', 'Distillation', 'Dancing Flame Experiment' & 'Secret Message Activity'. All the activities were wonderfully executed by the students. Then, the judges moved on to see the posters displayed by the students. At last a musical performance was given by Ms Aastha, Ms Kiran Lata and Mr Hemant.

The chief guest then delivered a motivational and inspirational speech to our students. He explained how science and technology is useful in day to day life and how it is making life easier. In his presidential remark he appreciated the efforts of the Eco Club students for making this event a

grand success. He emphasized that hard work is the only key to achieve success in the life. Dr Lalita Rawat and Dr Poonam Mehta also motivated our students with their words of appreciation. Meanwhile judges compiled the result and Dr Shallu Dogra, judge of the event, announced the result and prizes and certificates were distributed to the winners by our chief guest. 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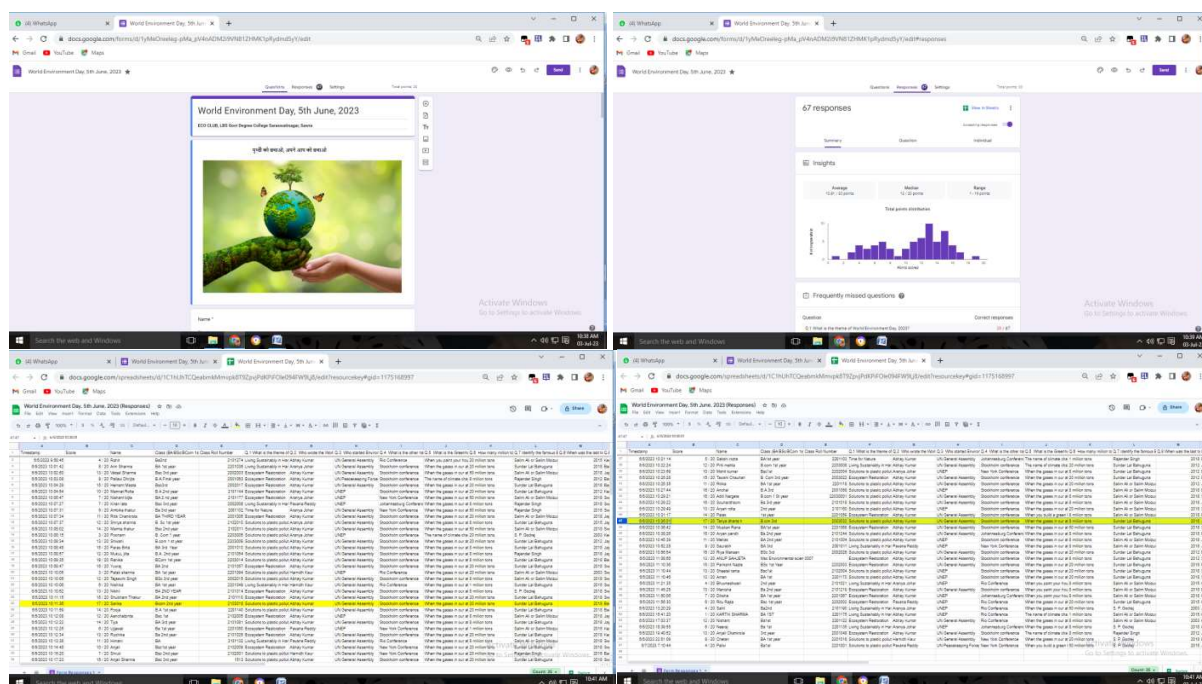


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World Environment Day (05.06.2023)
