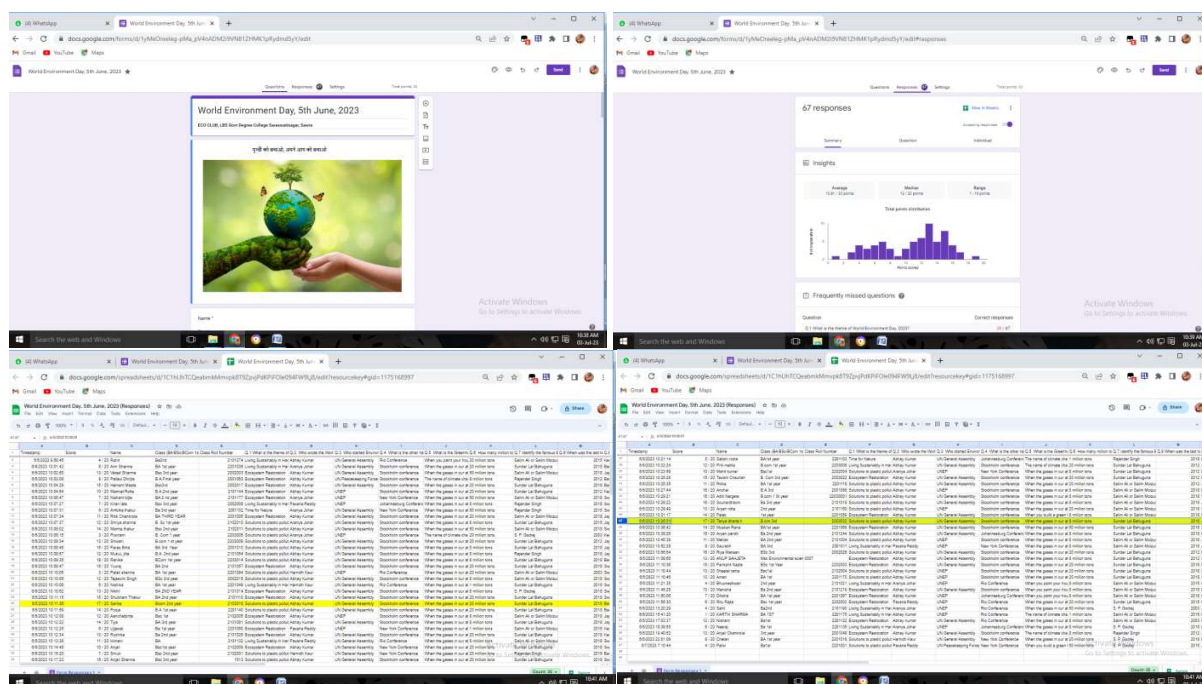


ANNUAL REPORT OF ECO CLUB (SESSION 2023-24)

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (05.06.2023)

On the 5th June 2023, Eco Club celebrated 'World Environment Day'. The aim of the event was to increase awareness among students about the importance of the environment and need to protect it. This year the theme of the 'World Environment Day' was 'Solutions to Plastic Pollution' so, Eco Club decided to clean the college premises and Hatkoti Temple area. Also an online quiz was conducted to spread awareness about the environment. Since, colleges were closed due to summer vacation only few students could gather to celebrate it. Cleanliness started from the college campus and then students moved to Hatkoti Temple. Students picked up all the trash and plastics from these said areas and put them in the dustbins. Everyone was performing his duties diligently and enthusiastically. Meanwhile the link of the online quiz was shared with the all the class groups and time limit of 20 minutes was given to complete it. A total of 66 students participated in the quiz. The questions of the quiz were based on environment and its related topics. The purpose of this small activity was to inculcate the sense of responsibility in our students towards the nature and well being of the ecosystem. With this the event came to an end on a positive note.





TREE PLANTATION DRIVE (09.08.2023)

Tree Plantation was organized in the college by Eco Club, Red Ribbon Club, NSS, NCC & Rovers & Rangers units of the college on 09th August, 2023. The site for the tree plantation which was selected a forest above the Himfed office in Sawra Kainchi. All the units along with their unit in charges moved to the location at 12:30 pm from the college. Principal of the college, Dr P.P. Chauhan and senior faculty members of the college, Dr Lalita Rawat and Dr Poonam Mehta actively took part in the tree plantation drive. Ms Kiran, Forest Guard, Sawra Range also accompanied us during the plantation drive. Students were very excited and moved with slogan recitation related to trees and its usages and flagged the banners of their units during the procession. After reaching the site of tree plantation, all the units chose their areas of tree plantation and started digging for the saplings to plant. Principal Sir and the teachers also planted saplings with the students of various units and motivated the students with their active presence. Ms Kiran kept guiding and telling students about the plantation processes, and maintenance of the saplings and their need for the human. Principal Sir also put light on the need of this tree plantation drive with his valuable words. It took about three hours to complete this task. After this all the students and teachers came back to the college and gathered in the college hall for the refreshment. A total of 75 saplings of Deodar tree were planted by all the units of the college. Students were excited and enthusiastically participated in this event. There were nearly 150 students and out of which 30 students of Eco Club were present during this event and made it a great success.



BIODIVERSITY EXPLORATION TOUR (16.09.2023)

A Biodiversity Exploration Tour was organized by Science Dept./Eco Club of the college on 16th September 2023. The site for this was chosen Giri Ganga. Giri Ganga is a very beautiful and mesmerizing place hidden near Kharapathar in Tehsil Jubbal. It is 30 Km away from Sawra and it is very less crowded and full of nature. There is an ancient temple, a holy lake around the temple and there are no concrete buildings nearby. The temple is situated in the middle of a dense but beautiful jungle. From the Giriganga temple, there is a trekking trail that goes all the way to the Kuppar peak. So it is the best place for biodiversity exploration.

All the teaching faculty of Science Department i.e. Dr Lokraj Sharma from Chemistry Dept. , Prof Goverdhan Chauhan from Maths Dept., Dr Punam Chauhan from Zoology Dept. and Dr Radha Raman Gautam from Physics Dept. with 28 Science Students started their journey from the college at 10:00 am and reached to the site around 12:00 o'clock. First of all, we visited to the temple and some students took holy bath in the lake. Afterwards we headed to the forest. While trekking in the forest lane, students kept watching the vegetation and the landscape. This is a small alpine valley with pine and deodar forests. After trekking for about two hours we came back to parking area and then move to Khada Pathar for the lunch. Then we came back to college around 3:30 pm. Students were very excited and happy during the trip.

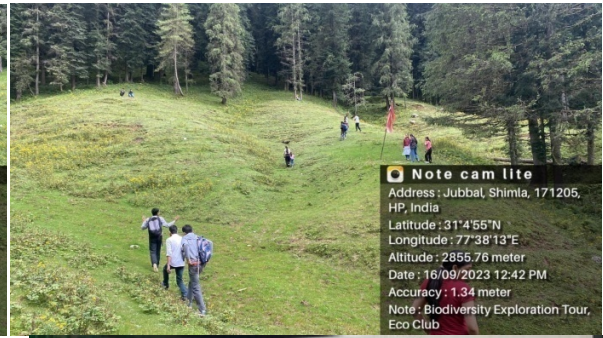

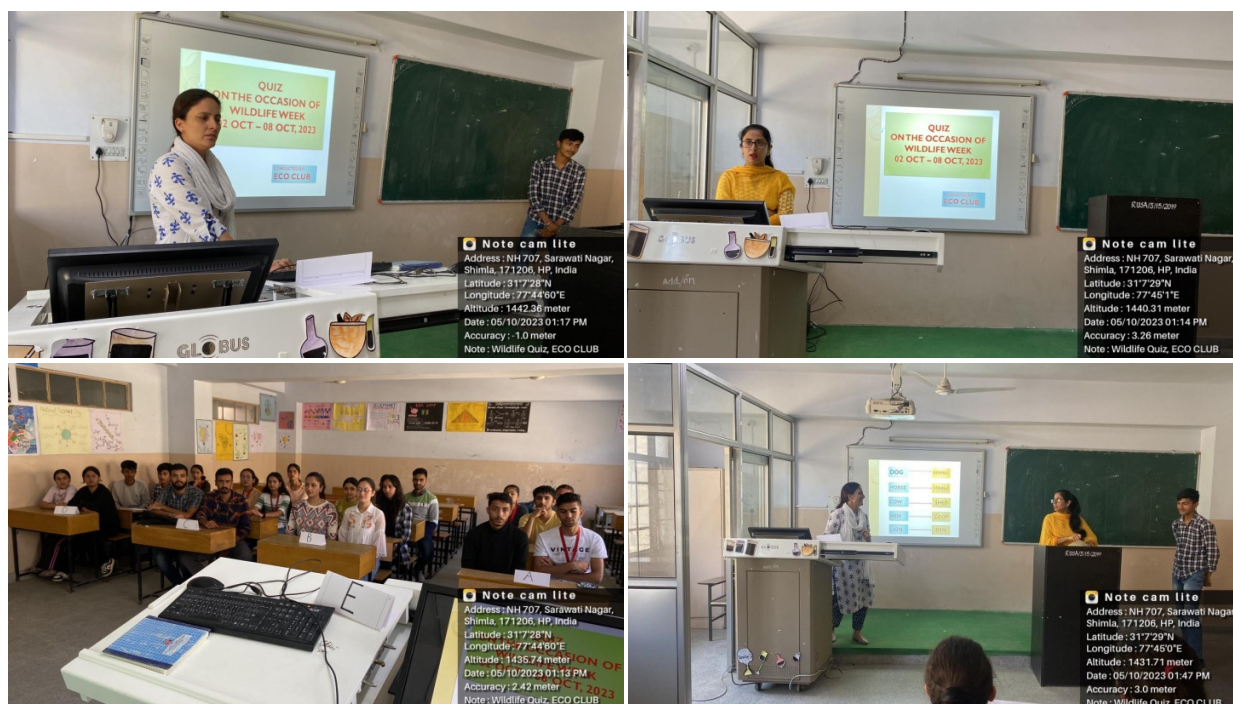
NATIONAL WILDLIFE WEEK (02ND OCT -08TH OCT, 2023)

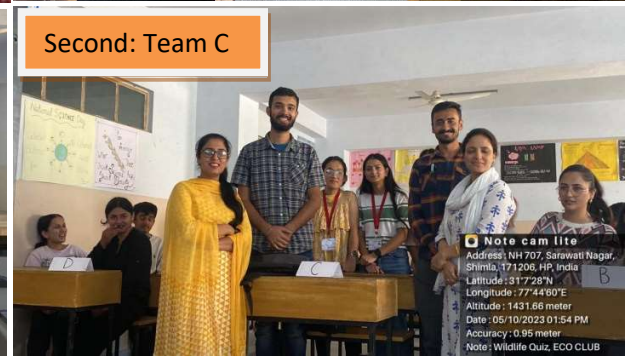

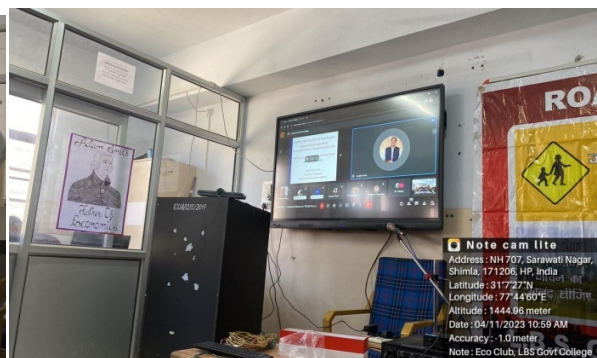


AWARENESS RALLY ON POLLUTION MENACE AND ROAD SAFETY RULES (04.11.2023)

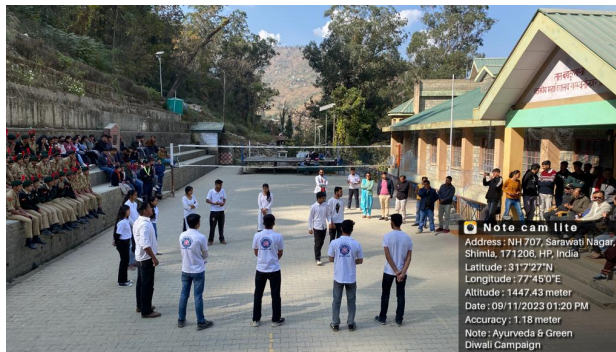
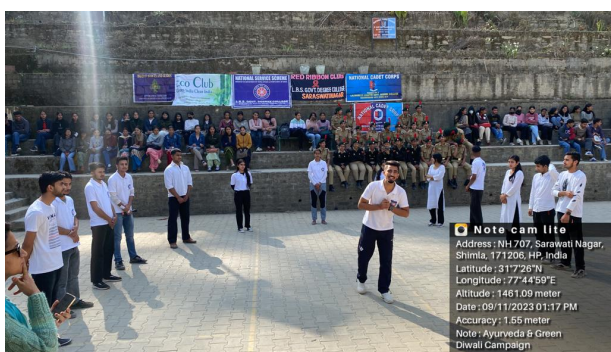

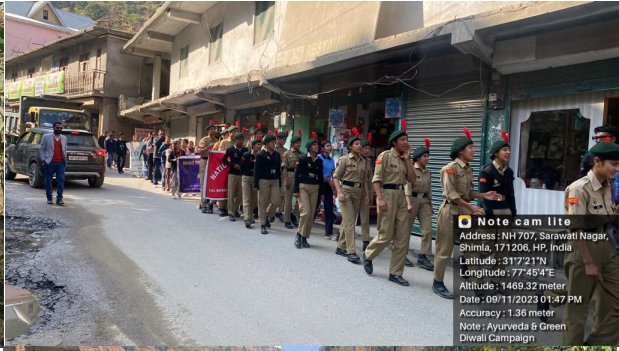




NUKKAD NATAK ON AYURVEDA & GREEN DIWALI CAMPAIGN (10.11.2023)

On this day, light is shed on efforts and achievements in the field of science and dialogue is held on implementing new technologies. In 1986, the National Council for Science & Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the government of India to mark February 28 as National Science Day. National Science Day was first celebrated on February 28, 1987. The NCSTC also founded the National Science Popularization awards to recognize the outstanding efforts in the area of science. Theme of The theme has been chosen for the purpose of raising public appreciation of scientific issues in a global context which is having a bearing on global Well-being.

On 28 February 2024, the Science and BCA/PGDCA Departments celebrated National Science Day. This year the theme of National Science Day was '**Indigenous technology for Viksit Bharat**'. Dr. P.P. 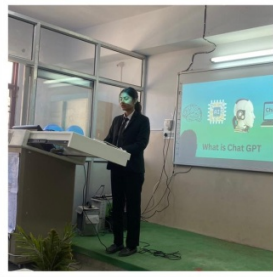
