Brief History of College

L.B.S Govt. Degree College now P.G. College was established in July 1986 to cater to the higher educational needs of the people of this area. Scholarships

The college awards scholarship to the IRDP/ SC/ST/OBC/Minorities students every year. In this session, an amount of Rs. 3,02,550/- was disbursed amongst the students. An amount of Rs. 1,35,000/-.for 09 students under Kalpana Chawla scholarship scheme. Six(06) students were awarded an amount of Rs. 60,000/- under Indira Gandhi UtkristChhatarvritiYojna.13 students were awarded PMS of RS. 55,250, one Student of economically backward class was awarded with RS. 12000 under PMS. Eight Students were awarded with RS. 38,800 under Centrally Sponsored PMS.

RUSA Grant

Under RUSA 2. a sum of Rs. 2, 00,000,000-(Two Crore only) grant was sanctioned to this college and 1st installment of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Crore) was received from RUSA under" RUSA Infrastructure Grant" for the Infrastructure Development of the College in the year 2018-19. Out of this an amount Rs. 10, 11,658/ was utilized during this session. An amount of 4, 15,925/ was used for renovation of girls' hostel and Rs. 1, 77,020/ were spent on procuring musical instruments. The remaining amount was utilized

for acquiring a bio-digester machine, Microscopy USB camera, contact —less hand sanitizer dispenser and software for library automation along with some other articles of utility.

Library

The college has a voluminous and spacious Library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about 12,074 books on different subjects. It subscribes to 3 newspapers and 18 periodicals to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is also member of Inflibnet Ahemdabad.
