❖ A Brief History of the College:

L.B.S Govt. Degree College was established in July 1986 to cater to the higher educational needs of the people of this area. The opening of the college in such a hard area marked the beginning of a new intellectual climate in the entire region. Since then this college has been providing various opportunities for the youth of this area and has been enabling them to acquire skills and confidence to face the challenges of the world. The college has come a long way with its motto *“To provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values & social commitment”*. During the session 2019-20, PG courses in the subjects of Political Science and History were introduced in the college.

In order to fulfil the required National quality yardsticks, the NAAC Peer Team visited the institution in April, 2017 and the college was accredited with B+ grade by the National Accreditation and Assessment Council(NAAC).

❖ Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff Position:

- **Teaching:** College has Twenty Seven (27) sanctioned posts of teaching staff including that of the Principal. Out of which one post of Principal and 8 posts of Asst. Professors in Chemistry, Botany, English, Economics, Mathematics, Commerce, Sanskrit and Librarian are lying vacant.
- **Non-Teaching :** College has (24) sanctioned posts of Non –Teaching staff out of which 19 are filled and 5 posts are lying vacant i.e. one each of J.L.A, Mechanic, Sweeper and of Water Carrier. The post of Tabla Vadak is filled on PTA/GIA basis. .

❖ **Results during the session 2021-22:**

The Results for the session 2020-21 for B.A/B.Sc/B.Com/ BCA courses were 100%

❖ **Scholarships:**

The college awards scholarship to the IRDP/ SC/ST/OBC/Minorities students every year. In this session, **total Scholarship amount under Fresh & Renewal Category which is approved by Directorate office is Rs. 3,09, 258.00/- (Three lakh nine thousand and two hundred fifty eight only).** An amount of Rs.1,50,000/- was disbursed to 10 students under Kalpana Chawla scholarship scheme. Under centrally sponsored Post Matric Scholarships , 38 SC students were awarded with Rs. 97,458/- and one student with disability was awarded Rs.15,000/- , 3 Students of economically backward class was awarded with Rs.45000/- and one student was awarded with Rs1800/- under IRDP Scholarship .

❖ **RUSA Grant:**

Under RUSA 2.0, a sum of Rs. 2, 00,00,000/- (Two Crore) grant was sanctioned to this college and the 1st installment of Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (One Crore) was received in 2018-19 and Second installment of Rs. 50,00,000/- was released in Jan 2022 from RUSA under “RUSA Infrastructure Grant” for the Infrastructure Development of the College. Out of this an amount Rs. 1,00,41.683/- has been utilized so far by the college and rest is in the process of utilization.

❖ **Library:**

The college has a voluminous and spacious Library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about 13000 books on different subjects. The college has subscribed 6 **newspapers** and 8 periodicals and five **Journals** to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is

also a member of **Inflibnet Ahmadabad**. The process of library automation which started in 2021 is in the stage of completion.

❖ **National Cadet Corps (NCC):**

The National Cadet Corps of this college has 103 Senior Division (SD) and Senior Wing (SW) vacancies. During the session 2020-2021, 18 cadets were enrolled in the Border Security Force. This year 35 new cadets enrolled themselves in NCC. Out of these 35 cadets, 21 cadets are against SD and 14 cadets are against SW vacancies for the Border Area.

Under the leadership of NCC officer LT .Dr. Rohit Mokta , NCC undertook various activities like Tree Plantation, Cleanliness Mission, Traffic Control, Blood Donation, Shanti March, Essay Writing Competition ,Social Work during Covid-19 Pandemic and Election duty etc. The role of Senior Under Officer Rajat Negi, S.U.O Neha Bandta and Under Officer Awantika Rolta, U.O Aditi Nagta, U.O Piyush Panatu and U.O Ritik and Dikshika was highly commended.

NCC and NSS units of LBS Govt. Degree College Saraswati Nagar organised a workshop on **Psychological Support for Pandemic Covid 19 Victims** in collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education [MGNCRE] on 5th June 2021 at 4:00 to 5:30 pm.

The college NCC Unit, with the technical support of Mr. Chander Mohan organised a **five day Yoga Camp from 16-06-2021 to 21-06-2021 on Google Meet** in which Under Officer Piyush Panatu, Senior Under Officer Neha, Prof. B.S. Pirta from Govt. College Seema, Dr. Sohan Chandel from Shimla ,LT. Vishal Yadav from Jhansi , Under Officer Piyush Panatu and Senior Under Officer Neha showcased different techniques of yoga which are helpful to lead a healthy life .

Seven cadets of the college attended a **Pre Republic Day Camp** at Chitkara University Chandigarh from 16th to 22nd September 2021. Out of these, four cadets namely U.O Piyush Panatu, U.O Ritik Bhagta, U.O Aditi Nagta ,Sgt. Sachin Negi were selected for the Pre RDC camp at Chandigarh from 22nd to 27th Sept. 2021.

ATC 220 (Annual Training Camp) was organised in the college campus w. e. f. **23rd to 29th Oct. 2021**.

This Year, 17 cadets of this college appeared in B-certificate exam at Shimla on 20th Feb. 2022 and 14 cadets appeared in C-certificate exam at Solan on 27th Feb. 2022.

❖ **National Service Scheme (NSS)**

Two units of NSS are running in the college under the supervision of programme officers - Asst. Prof. Pawan Kumar (Unit-I) and Asst. Prof. Preeti Panta (unit II). During the session, 200 candidates from different streams of B.A., B.Sc., B. Com. and BCA were enrolled as NSS volunteers. NSS body was framed in September 2021 in which **Pallavi Sharma** was appointed as President Unit-1, **Rishabh Mehta** as President Unit-2, **Tanisha** and **Priyanshi** as General secretary and Joint secretary respectively.

NSS organized a **Tree Plantation** drive on 14th August on the eve of “**Van – Mahotsav**” on the college campus and on the same day **plastic bottles & Polythene** were collected from the college campus and from the bank of **Pabber River** . ‘**International Yoga Day**’ was celebrated through online mode on 21st June, 2021. **One day special camp** was organized on the eve of **NSS day** on 24th Sept, 2021. **Swachhta Pakhwada** on the occasions of “**Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav**” & **Golden Jubilee- 50 Years of State hood** was celebrated in the month of October 2021. **Independence Day** was celebrated on 15th August 2021 by the volunteers of NSS.
