ANNUAL REPORT 2016-17

The college was established in July 1986 to cater to the higher educational needs of the people of this area. The opening of this college in such a hard area was a step towards realization of higher educational requirements of the local youth. Since then this college has been providing various opportunities for the youth of this area and has been enabling them to acquire skills and confidence to be face the world. The college has come a long way with its motto "To provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values & social commitment".

Today we have 638 students (girls 354 and boys 284) pursuing four UG courses, i.e. Arts, Science, Commerce and B.C.A.

Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff Position

Twenty four(25) posts of teaching staff including that of the Principal have been sanctioned, out of which one post of Principal, five posts of Asst. Professors are presently lying vacant (one post in Chemistry, one in Physics, one in Botany, one in Physical Education and one in History) and one post of Librarian is also lying vacant.

Scholarships

The college awards scholarship to the IRDP and SC/ST students every year. In this session, an amount of Rs.3,34,444/ for 66SC students, an amount of Rs. 15,600 for 12 IRDP students and an amount of Rs. 3,60,000/- for 24 students under Kalpana Chawla scholarship scheme is under process.

UGC Grant

A grant of Rs. 14, 00,000/- (fourteen lakh only) was received from UGC during XIIth plan period under remedial and coaching classes and is under process of utilisation.

Library

The college has a voluminous and spacious Library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about 10,939 books on different subjects. It subscribes to 6 newspapers and 18 periodicals to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is also

member of Inflibnet Ahmedabad. 84 new books were added during the session with more emphasis on competitive books.

Cultural Activities
