***** Brief History of the College:

Located in the idyllic and enticing Pabbar valley, in the vicinity of Mata Hateshwari temple, LBS GDC Saraswati Nagar has served as an institution that shapes the future and directs aspirations of pupils toward successful careers and higher goals of life. This academic institution unites the two different streams of thought in its approach towards education: the traditional wisdom of the past and the modern contemporary rational knowledge of the day. L.B.S Govt. Degree College was established in July 1986 to cater to the higher educational needs of the people of this area. The opening of the college in such a hard area marked the beginning of a new intellectual climate in the entire region. Since then this college has been providing various opportunities for the youth of this area and has been enabling them to acquire skills and confidence to face the challenges of the world. The college has come a long way with its motto "To provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values & social commitment". During the session 2019-20, PG courses in the subjects of Political Science and History were introduced in the college.

In order to fulfil the required quality yardstick as per with the national level, The NAAC Peer Team visited the institute in Nov. 2023 and the college was accredited with B grade by the National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC).

BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE COLLEGE:

A) EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND COURSES OFFERED

1. UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL

The college has 4 UG pass courses: B.A., B.Sc., B.Com. and BCA operational in full swing. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and annual system have been introduced from the academic session 2018-19 by HP University. Within CBCS, students have complete freedom to choose their subjects from a pool of subjects suggested by the UGC. As CBCS strives to create a holistic syllabus, therefore from the session 2016-2017, in addition to dedicated focus on a discipline through core paper, elective papers have been added. Besides, keeping in line with the vision of the Government, special emphasis has been given to Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses, Skill Enhancement Courses and Generic courses. However, BCA follows the semester system.

2. POST-GRADUATE LEVEL

The College provides Post-graduate courses in Political Science and History. The strength in these courses has not only increased but also has given good results. Besides it, self-financing course in **PGDCA** is also operational in this College.

B) INFRASTRUCTURAL FACILITIES

We have upgraded our infrastructure and are constantly in process of doing the same, so that our students find themselves second to none as far as exposure and modern facilities that supplement education are concerned. Our achievements include:

a) LIBRARY

The college has a voluminous and spacious Library which caters to the educational and recreational needs of both students and the staff. It has about **13290** books on different subjects. It has subscribed **7** newspapers and **12** periodicals to facilitate the students and staff members. The college is also a member of **Inflibnet Ahmedabad**. The process of library automation was completed in the year 2022.

b) LABORATORIES

The college has 4 spacious Science laboratories, 1 Geography lab, and 1 Language lab.

c) HOSTEL

There is a girls' hostel in the college that provides boarding facilities to the meritorious and deserving students. The hostel is equipped with Water Purifiers, Solar-heating Systems, Sick Rooms, Guest Room and Reading Room.

d) COMPUTER LAB

Keeping in pace with the hi-tech and competitive world, the college is equipped with **47 computers** which are installed in the **3 IT labs**. There are 16 computers in language lab. These labs are also provided with **over-head projectors** and **broad-band connections**. Besides IT department, students from various faculties are being benefitted by the Computer Labs.

e) **SEMINAR HALL**

To hold the meetings of the Staff Council and to organize Conferences and Seminars, the college has a well-furnished Seminar hall.

f) CANTEEN

The college canteen is a place of refreshment for the college staff as well as students. It offers a great variety of food items and snacks at nominal prices.

g) PLAYGROUND and SYNTHETIC TRACK

The playground of the college provides for organizing various outdoor games like volleyball, kabaddi, boxing, etc. Besides, there is a synthetic athletic track awaiting completion.

h) GYMNASIUM

Keeping in mind the fitness in this hectic and stressful era, the college provides free of cost gymnasium facility to the students and the college staff.

i) PAVILION

The college can boast of a magnificent pavilion building built adjacent to the ground to witness plethora of sports events, besides a store room for sports equipments.
