NSS Activities for the Session 2021-2022

<u>Clean India Campaign / Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsa</u>v

NSS Units of LBS Govt. PG College Sarawati Nagar has successfully conducted the following Activities under the theme of Clean India Campaign.

I. Bhaang Ukhado Abhiyan:-

The clean India Campaign was started on the eve of 75th Independence Day on 15 August 2021. On this day Bhaang Ukhado Abhiyan was organised in the college campus and nearest areas of the campus. 50 volunteers from both the units have participated in this camp.

V.One Day Camp on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti:



One day camp on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti was organized on 2nd october2021 under the theme of Swatch Bharat Abhiyan [Clean India Campaign]in which 170 NSS volunteers took participation. The volunteers undertook cleanliness campaign in the campus to make it neat and clean and give a boost to the Swatch Bharat Abhiyan. The volunteers cleaned the entire campus

and collected all the litter in bags for disposal. The volunteers also maintained the gardens of the college.

Vi. One day cleanliness camp on cutting of shrubs: -

A one-day camp on shrubs cutting has been organized in the college campus by the NSS Units of the college on 9th October 2021. 100 volunteers from both the units participated in this camp. All the unwanted shrubs were cut by the Volunteers.





VI. One Day awareness campaign under NSS to check spread of Coronavirus:

As a whole the main objective of this camp was to make people aware regarding the importance of health and hygiene in our life's.

NSS 5-days State level Self – Defence Mega Camp Girls[29th Nov to 4th Dec 2021]

For the first time Lal Bahadur Shastri Government PG college Saraswati Nagar got the opportunity to host State level Self-defense Mega Camp for girls. In which around 100 NSS female volunteers from 13 colleges participated.



NSS Mega Camp Day -1 Activity Report:-

On the 30th of December 2021, National Service Scheme state level self-defense five-day camps started in Lal Bahadur Shastri Government PG college Saraswati Nagar in which firstly all the campers were gathered in the ground for flag hoisting, where the flag was hoisted by Dr. Gopal Dutt Sharma[retired professor] being the chief guest of the opening ceremony. 
RD parade is held at New Delhi every year from January 01 to 31. There were 100 NSS volunteers selected for RD Parade from every direction all over India and Mr. Banit Ranta, 3rd year student of LBS PG College Saraswati Nagar was one of them. The selection process was done by three criteria which included the drill, cultural activities and finally the interview. Before final RDC there are selection camps held at college level, University level, State level, and North zone level. The North zone level camp or the PRE- RD camp was held in Biyani College, Jaipur (kalwar).

In the PRE–RD selection camp there were a total of 22 volunteers from Himachal Pradesh among which only four volunteers were selected for

the RD parade. Lastly out of 167 volunteers only 100 volunteers were selected from all over India. From the past two years due to COVID restrictions number of volunteers selected was limited to 100.
